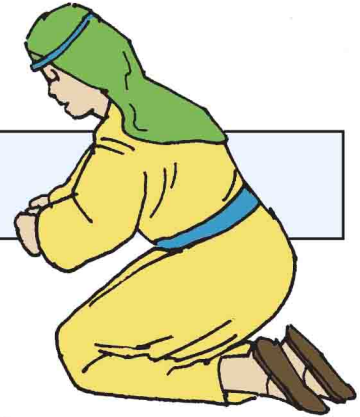




What will every tongue confess?

Cross out every letter P for pride and read the message that remains.



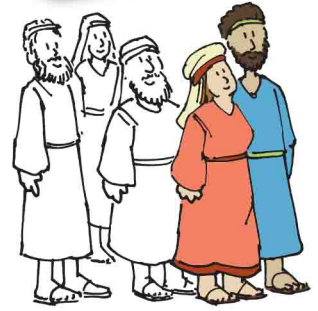

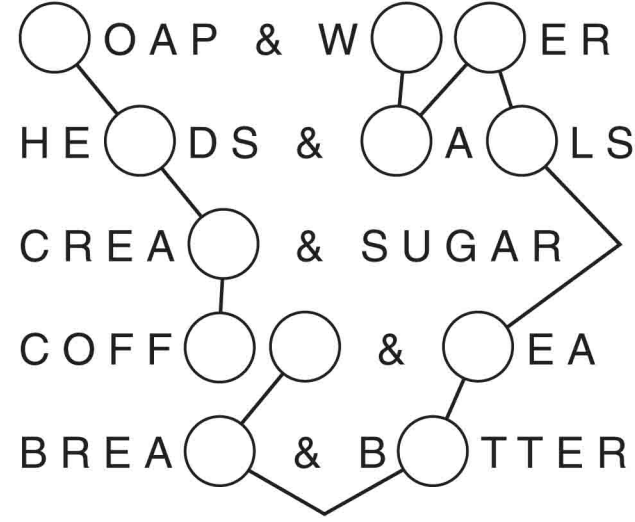

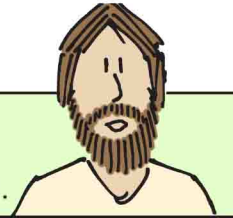
